Fourth and fifth grade students of all reading levels are invited to participate in the Battle of the Books Literacy Club. By choosing to participate in this club, your child will be introduced to a variety of fiction and non-fiction books. The winning Fox Hollow team will then represent our school to compete against other schools in the Semi-Finals. The top 6 Cherry Creek schools will compete at the district competition.
